

T.P.S. Manoeuvring SUIT

Manoeuvring suit - Registered design CE pr EN 1913 standard. 3 mm neoprene fabric with titanium and nylon on both sides. Very high level insulation from 0.90 to 1.5 immersed clo following the type of underwear worn (minimum required for a category A survival suit: 0.75 immersed clo). Dry, isothermal, buoyant and light (3.6 kg). Removable mittens. Fly with waterproof storm flap Removable boots (on neoprene socks) enabling the use of other forms of shoes. Safety harness. On option: Automatic self-righting lung system. 2 ITEMS OF SAFETY CLOTHING IN 1: In extreme weather, when foul weather gear is no longer effective, you can carry out important manoeuvres and stay warm and dry wearing the Thermal Protection Survival (T.P.S.). If you should fall overboard, it is also a survival suit with a simple and safe fastening system similar to the waterproof bag. It avoids the drawbacks of a standard waterproof fastener: sticking, maintenance. Easy to slip on, comfortable, its buoyancy and thermal insulation make the TPS a "Must" for preventive safety.
